English Studies is designed to support students in developing proficiency in English to enhance their personal, social and vocational lives. Students who study this course gain good preparation for communication in the workplace and their daily lives. This course is not considered suitable for students who wish to study at a tertiary level as you will not be able to apply for an ATAR.

Mandatory Modules

Year 11: Achieving through English:

English and the worlds of Education, careers and community.

Year 12: We are Australians:

English in citizenship, community and cultural identity.

What will I be doing in this course?

English Studies addresses the needs of a specific group of students who wish to complete and be awarded an HSC, but who are seeking an alternative to the current Standard English Course.

The course is not examined externally. Results in the course are not eligible for an ATAR.

This is a skills-based course with opportunities for flexible delivery to meet students' needs. The interests and needs of students will determine all aspects of the course including areas such as modules studied and texts and activities chosen.
