ANZAC Day

ANZAC Day will once again fall during the school holidays this year. Protocol dictates that schools holding assemblies to recognise the day must do so before, not after the 25th. As such we will be holding our School ANZAC service at our regular assembly this Wednesday the 10th.

As always students and staff will be marching in the Blayney ANZAC Day march on the 25th and attending the service afterwards. Students wishing to participate in the march are asked to meet at the Post Office at 10:30 in their formal school uniform. Students who elect to march will be recognised with a School Service Merit Award, a Certificate of Recognition during the end of year awards ceremonies and Vivo points for school service. Students who attend other village ANZAC ceremonies in their Blayney High School uniform will also be eligible for this recognition.

We hope to see as many students as possible in attendance.

Parent/Teacher interviews

Our Parent Teacher interviews will be held early next term on Monday 6th May.

Bookings will be done online through the Sentral Parent Portal. By logging on, you will be able to see your child's teachers for each of their subjects and a list of when they are available. By clicking on the relevant time slots you will be able to reserve these slots and print a timetable of who you would like to see and when.

If you have not yet registered for the Sentral Portal, letters were sent out a few weeks ago with the link to the login page and a unique code to access the details of your children. This can be re-generated for you and sent home or emailed to you.

Any parent who wishes to book appointments but does not have interned access can ring the office on 6368 2100. The helpful ladies in the office will be able to book interview times for you and send home a printout.

We welcome any feedback on this new system and the Sentral Portal in general.


