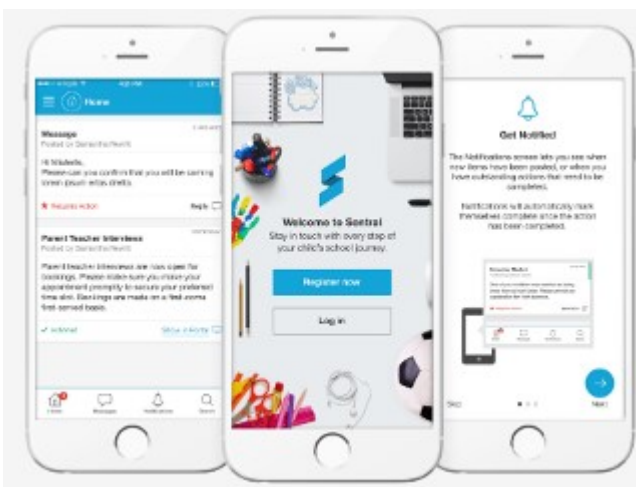
Year 11 'Exam Week'

In their recent HSC review the New South Wales Education Standards Authority (NESA) mandated that there can be no more than 1 assessment delivered in Year 11 that is a traditional 'exam'. As a result, last year we held no exam practice for our Year 11 students until their final end of course exams. The general feeling amongst teachers and students was that this was quite stressful and it did not allow teachers to adequately give students feedback on their exam performance prior to the major assessment.

This year we will be holding a practice 'exam week' in Week 3. This will not be a traditional exam period where we hold no classes and students attend only for their exams. Instead, teachers will be using this week to practice exam style questions in class. These will be a mix of multiple choice, short answer and essay based questions. While these tasks will not be counted towards the students' final assessment grades, we believe this practice will be an invaluable learning tool for both teachers and students themselves to assess how they are going in their courses so far and what they need to do to improve before the end of course exams in Term 3 that do count!


