<u>Re: Notification of Construction for Road Works – Carcoar Street,</u> <u>Blayney</u>

Council was successful in receiving funding under "Fixing Local Roads Round One" from Transport for NSW for the rehabilitation and repair of heavily cracked pavement on Carcoar Street, Blayney.

Council advises there will be 2 stages for the construction works:

Stage 1 – Carcoar Street, Blayney between Mid Western Highway and Charles Street.

Stage 2 - Carcoar Street, Blayney between Charles Street and Orange Road.

Council wish to advise that it will be commencing preliminary works on Stage 1 - Carcoar Street, Blayney between the Mid Western Highway and Charles Street with works scheduled to commence the week beginning 26 October 2020.

Residents will still have access to their properties whilst works are in progress.



School Travel for 2021



2021 school travel applications are now open

Applications for student travel in 2021 opened from Monday 12 October 2020.

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass for 2021 can now <u>apply</u> online. A new application should be submitted if a student is applying for a school travel pass for the first time or requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).

Students who have changed school/campus, changed address, repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should <u>re-apply or update their details</u>.

*Applications must be completed by the student's parent or legal guardian if the student is aged under 16 years. Students 16 years and over must complete the application form themselves.

Where there is a change of distance eligibility based on a student's grade, the system will automatically update a student's entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new <u>eligibility criteria</u>, they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If a student needs to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to <u>https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails</u>

Applications need to be submitted before **31 December 2020** to ensure that current student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card remains valid. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2020, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2021.

Students residing in Rural and Regional (R&R) areas should receive their travel pass at the commencement of the new school year from their nominated operator, this may be distributed via the school or sent direct to their address. **Note**: some R&R operators do not issue travel passes. Students/Parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

New Concession Entitlement Cards

Transport for NSW will be replacing the below cards with Transport Concession Entitlement Cards (TCEC) from October 2020:

- Senior Secondary Student Concession Card (16 years and over) also used by Mature Secondary Students (18 years and over), Distance Education Students and Home School Students
- Proof of Age card (when a student under 16 years of age looks older)
- Boarder Rail Pass.

All previous cards will be valid until they expire. Students who require a Transport Concession Entitlement Card should speak with their school administration staff.

2021 Blayney Shire Music Scholarship

To provide one full scholarship and one encouragement award for one year, for students between 7 and 18 years (inclusive) who live in the Blayney Shire and wish to further their music studies. Scholarships will be awarded for tuition at Orange Regional Conservatorium (ORC) and Mitchell Conservatorium, Bathurst (MC).

Adjudicators will include representatives from Blayney Shire Council, ORC and MC.

The tuition program will include a mix of practical and theoretical components, tailored to meet the individual student's needs, with the specifics of the program to be negotiated after the award is made.

Basic Criteria & Program

Applicants must want to progress their studies in music and be able to demonstrate a commitment to the same. Applicants with a demonstrated financial need will be given priority consideration. Scholarships will include, in the normal course; tuition, musicianship and ensemble activity. Each program will be individually tailored by the relevant Conservatorium to meet the recipient's specific needs.

Selection criteria to include:

- Demonstrated track record; contribution to the Blayney community
- Commitment to further music studies; undertake practical & theory exam
- Potential
- Musicality
- Financial need
- Parents/guardians commitment to travel/attendance
- Compliance with the conditions, policies and procedures of the relevant Conservatorium where the scholarship is awarded

Scholarships to commence from Term 1, 2021.

Other Conditions

- Blayney scholarship holders may not concurrently hold an award from ORC or MC.
- Successful applicants need to:
 - Comply with Conservatoriums conditions, policies and procedures
 - Attend core performance commitments
 - Attend agreed community performances, including a joint ORC and MC coordinated concert to be held in the Blayney Shire where certificates will be presented to scholarship winners after completing their first year of studies under the program.
 - Be available for media/promotions
- Applicant must be a resident of Blayney Shire; proof of Blayney Shire residency must be provided when lodging application (rates notice/letter from renting agents).
- Scholarship cannot be awarded to the same individual within a 12 month period after the award year –
 exceptions to be considered on merits.
- Decision of the adjudication panel is final; no correspondence will be entered into.
