## Blayney High Bulletin - Issue 1 Term 3 - Week 1 - 22 July 2022

### Term 3 COVID Settings

COVID settings for Term 3 are a continuation to those in place at the end of Term 2. As such, unless unwell, students should see no real impact upon the classroom and extracurricular opportunities we are able to offer.

Students who are sick with any sign of respiratory illness are asked to remain at home and continue to test using supplied RATs. If a positive result is received it is important to continue to follow current NSW Health advice.

Masks are not mandatory. However, the Department of Education stance is that their use is 'strongly recommended' based on Department of Health advice. With this in mind I ask all students to consider wearing a mask at school to help contain the potential spread of the expected new COVID wave. The wearing of masks does remain personal choice and no student will be questioned on their individual decision.

RATs are once again being made available to those families who would like more. We have not yet received our new supply but we are expecting up to 5 more RATs per student. Once we have received these they will be distributed to students. The use of RATs remains discretionary and students or parents who have previously indicated they do not want these will not be issued these in the next round.

### Semester Two Exams

To give certainty to students the decision has been made to proceed with Semester Two exams for students in years 7-10. These will be held in Week 4 Term 4. They are held early to allow staff to mark these but they do not reflect the end of courses. All subjects will teach at least 1 more topic following these exams with an assessment included.

Students in Year 7 and 8 will have exams in

English

Maths

History or Geography (depending on their Semester Two timetable)

PDHPE

Year 7 students will also have an exam in Science. Year 8 students will not have their Science exam as they will sit the Online VALID test in Week 3. This test is the science equivalent of NAPLAN and so will replace the Science exam for those students.

## How do I check what version I am?

From your app, go into Settings cog in the top left corner of the dashboard screen, then into App Version. (See image below.)

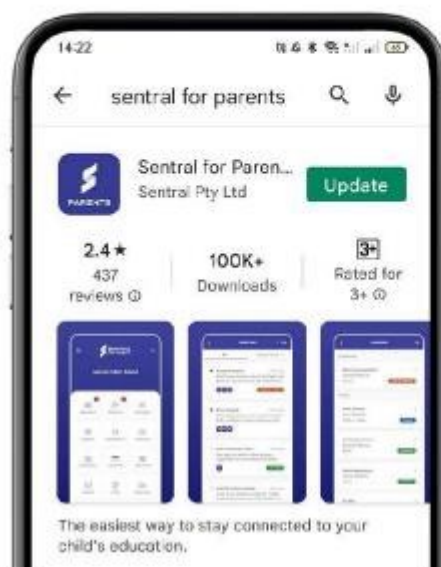


## I am on Version 3 or 4
