Over the next few months every light in the school will be upgraded to an LED to greatly improve lighting around the school and reduce power consumption. The process will begin in the Gym over the break before rolling through the classrooms in Term 4.

Agriculture Fencing Update

I am expecting the approval for the new Agriculture fence soon. Unfortunately the process of gaining quotes and departmental approval process has taken a lot longer than initially planned. I am still hopeful to have this project complete by the end of 2022 to allow us to once again bring agricultural stock back onto school grounds.

While it is disappointing we have lost this opportunity in 2022 our Agriculture students have been fully involved in alternative syllabus activities that have allowed them the opportunity to pass all course outcomes. We are extremely grateful to members of our community who have made their properties and animals available for us to visit and be involved in this work.

In recognition that we have not had the associated feed costs for stock we have decided to waive the Semester 2 fee for all students studying Agriculture. All parents and carers concerned will receive a letter regarding this soon.

Parents who have already paid this fee will be able to have this held as a credit towards other school costs including excursions or request a refund. Details will be included in the letter.

Important Information: Sentral for Parents App



From **Thursday 23rd June 2022**, versions 3 and 4 of the Sentral for Parents App will no longer be supported. If you are on one of these versions, you need to update your app to continue accessing information and receiving notifications.

How do I check what version I am?

From your app, go into Settings cog in the top left corner of the dashboard screen, then into App Version. (See image below.)



I am on Version 3 or 4

You will need to update your app. Go to your device's app store and search for Sentral for Parents and then select Update (see image below). Or you can access the app store using the QR codes below. After the update, when you go back into the app, you will be required to re-enter your login credentials.
