Uniform

Late last year we began the process of surveys and gathering thoughts and suggestions on our school uniform. A huge amount of data was collected from students and parents and a student uniform group has been working with our P&C on this for the majority of the year.

Following a lengthy planning and consultation process I will be making an announcement at this week's assembly to students regarding the first step in our uniform update. A change will be made at the start of term 4 for students in Years 7 – 10.

Following our assembly I will be emailing all parents and carers with details of this update.

Social Media

Over recent weeks I have become aware that a small number of students are using private Social Media groups to bully, threaten and harass other students. In particular there are a number of Instagram sites that have been set up using the school crest. I can confirm that the school does not have an official Instagram account and that the content of these pages is in no way endorsed by the school.

Pleasingly many students and parents have been making me aware of these accounts and calling out the unacceptable behaviour of the students involved. Significant consequences have been imposed on students involved in this over the past few weeks and the Department of Education has been quick to work with Instagram to close these pages down.

Some students have also created Snapchat groups which are also used to post inappropriate content. Some students have been invited unknowingly to these groups. Police are investigating who has set up these groups.

Very little of this behaviour is happening in school time. It is happening before and after school but is seriously affecting the learning and safety of those involved while at school as a result of the things posted the previous evening or over a weekend.

It is vital for students and parents to continue calling out this online behaviour whether directly related to the school or not. Our Police Youth Liaison Officer has recently been in to talk with students once again about the responsible use of Social Media and the serious laws regarding this.



What to do if students are bullied or threatened on Social Media

- Take a screenshot of the message and show parents and the school. These screenshots must be reported and deleted within 24 hours. If they are kept longer than that the law says they are being kept for the purpose of bullying. **Report and delete**.
- If the abuse or threat is from an adult report directly to the police as well as letting the school know.
- Do not respond. If a student responds with a threat or abuse of their own this can be screenshot and used to show their misuse. A student cannot claim to be the victim if they have done this. Incidents such as this will be treated as a conflict rather than bullying.
- Block the threatening user immediately
- Leave a group that is involved in inappropriate online behaviour
- Report to the esafety Commission here https://www.esafety.gov.au/report

The school will

- Implement safety plans at school to keep all parties safe
- Work with parents and students to resolve the matter
- Take disciplinary action up to and including suspension for students failing to follow safety plans
- Involve police where required

Our School value of 'Respect for Others', in particular 'Treat Others as You Wish to be Treated' is not just relevant in school hours. I ask students and parents to continue to be vigilant regarding these pages or groups and continue to report these unacceptable behaviours. If the school knows about it, we can deal with it. Not reporting the matters to us allows the behaviours to continue.

Let's work together to keep our students safe at school and online.
















Schools Spectacular 2022

From your app, go into Settings cog in the top left corner of the dashboard screen, then into App Version. (See image below.)




I am on Version 3 or 4




